Progress continues this week on the Ichthys LNG Project being constructed by JKC Australia LNG Pty Ltd (JKC), with works being undertaken at Howard Springs Accommodation Village, and at the onshore LNG facility at Blaydin Point.

Blaydin Point

This week's expected activities include:

- Commencement of nearshore test piling that will ensure the geotechnical information supports design requirements
- Ongoing construction of the Module Offloading Facility including some removal of nearshore coastal vegetation
- Operation of two shifts working 10-hours per shift, with maintenance performed between each shift
- Wickham Point Road intersection upgrade continues.
- Expected increase in heavy rock transport from 14 to 17 trucks per day from DAC Howard West quarry (Yarrawonga) to the Blaydin Point site via Jenkins Road
- Two trucks per day transporting crushed rock from Mt Bundy quarry to the concrete batching plant on Channel Island road
- Ten trucks per day transporting smaller rock from Yebna quarry south of Jenkins Road to Blaydin Point site
- Six trucks transporting concrete from a batching plant on Channel Island Road, a short journey to the construction site at Blaydin Point.

Howard Springs Accommodation Village

This week's expected activities include:

Monday to Saturday:

- Begin construction of part of the sewerage headworks on Lambrick Avenue, offset 15 metres on the southern side of the road, and within the

existing easement

- Exploration works on roadside verge for the termination of the sewerage pressure main into the existing system, at Larrakia Road, Rosebery
- Ongoing road widening adjacent to the accommodation village on Howard Springs Road – this will continue to involve one way traffic management and speed restrictions
- Ongoing site preparation and construction activities
- Construction hours from 7am to 6pm
- Delivery of accommodation modules to be transported from East Arm Wharf to site, are now anticipated in early September

Sunday:

- Construction hours restricted to 9am to 5pm
- Construction activity will be managed to ensure most occurs on the Howard Springs Road side of the construction site, to minimise impacts on nearby residents

Stow Road Sewerage Pump Station:

Our re-design has been finalised following consultation with key stakeholders including the local community.

Appropriate dust suppression is in place, and noise and dust impacts will continue to be monitored across all JKC construction sites.
