However, regardless of how competent the drivers are, or how well maintained our trucks are, we will continue to ask the Darwin community, for your patience and caution when driving near our trucks during this busy time.

Construction

This week JKC Australia LNG Pty Ltd (JKC) advises that construction activities at the Howard Springs Accommodation Village and at the onshore LNG facilities at Blaydin Point will include:

Blaydin Point

- Ongoing ground improvements for the Module Offloading Facility causeway
- Heavy rock transport by 18 trucks per day from DAC Howard West quarry (Yarrowonga) via Jenkins Road to Blaydin Point site
- Small rock transport by 10 trucks per day from Yebna quarry south of Jenkins Road to Blaydin Point site

- Two trucks per day transporting crushed rock from Mt Bunday quarry to the concrete batching plant on Channel Island Road
- Six trucks per day transporting concrete from a batching plant on Channel Island Road to Blaydin Point site
- Nine water trucks per day accessing Paspaley's Pond, off Channel Island Road, to Blaydin Point site
- Operation of two shifts working 10 hours per shift, with maintenance performed between each shift
- Ongoing upgrading of Wickham Point Road Intersection

Howard Springs Accommodation Village

Monday to Saturday:

- Works have begun on the sewerage pump station near Stow Road – to ensure minimal community impact construction access will mostly occur from within the Village site
- Ongoing construction of sewerage headworks in Lambrick Avenue, including crossing Mitchell Creek
- Larrakia Drive will be closed to through vehicular and pedestrian traffic at the existing drain easement (see map attached) from September 24 to October 15 for essential sewer upgrade works. Local residents are urged to seek an alternative route during this time
- Ongoing road widening adjacent to the Accommodation Village on Howard Springs Road expected to be complete by end of September - one way traffic management and speed restrictions are in place

- Begin installation of a site boundary fence on Stow Road. Permits are in place to remove a number of small trees along the boundary to straighten the site perimeter over the next few weeks. The trees do not form part of the existing 50m vegetation buffer zone
- Delivery of accommodation modules being transported from East Arm Wharf to site continues every 3 weeks until June 2013, avoiding peak hour traffic periods
- Ongoing site preparation and construction activities
- Construction hours from 7am to 6pm
Sunday:
- Construction hours restricted to 9am to 5pm

Appropriate dust suppression and street sweeping measures are in place, and noise, dust and road condition will continue to be monitored across all JKC construction sites.
