

**This week JKC advises that construction activities at our work sites will include:**

**Blaydin Point**

- Rehabilitation soon to begin on a site at Yarrowonga Road, Yarrowonga, for parking
- Remedial works on the Wickham Point Road/Blaydin Point site intersection will commence as soon as approvals are gained. Traffic control will be in place
- Heavy rock transport by eight road trains daily from DAC Howard West quarry (Yarrowonga) via Stuart Highway and Jenkins Road to Blaydin Point
- Small rock transport by eight road trains daily from Yebna quarry via Stuart Highway and Jenkins Road to site
- Twenty-three road trains daily transporting crushed rock from Mt Bunday quarry via the Arnhem and Stuart highways and Jenkins Road to site
- Six concrete trucks daily transporting concrete from a batching plant on Channel Island Road to site
- Four concrete trucks daily travelling from Winnellie batching plant along Tiger Brennan Drive, Wishart Road, Elrundie Avenue and Channel Island Road to site
- Seven trucks daily from interstate via Stuart Highway, Jenkins Road and Channel Island Road to site
- Three trucks daily transporting Office Modules from East Arm Port to site
- Two road trains daily carrying fill from Howard Springs quarry via Howard Springs Road, Stuart Highway and Jenkins Road to site
- Two road trains on an as needs basis from Syrimi Road via Wishart Road, Elrundie Avenue and Channel Island Road to site
- Two shifts working 10 hours per shift, with maintenance performed between each shift

**For those using this area for recreation please be aware of Project vehicles, including road trains. Ensure you are clearly visible and you have lights on your bicycle. Always wear reflective clothing.**

**Marine Safety**

**For those using the harbour please remember to stay well clear of the 250m marine safety zone surrounding construction activities for the Module Offloading Facility and Jetty at Blaydin Point and keep well away from large vessels.**

**Howard Springs Accommodation Village**

- Installation of street lights on Howard Springs Road will continue for the next 4-6 weeks

- Construction of the sewerage headworks linking with Palmerston sewerage system including work on Lambrick Avenue near Zuccoli and adjacent to Stuart Highway is now complete. Commissioning will be completed by the end of May
- Traffic control will remain in place on Lambrick Avenue as part of sewer pump station works
- Power supply to the Stow Road sewer pump station is now complete
- Madsen Road access will require access from Stow Road to complete this work in the coming weeks with work to continue from within the site as much as possible
- Internal security fence installation is ongoing and will be completed this month
- Next shipment of accommodation modules will be transported to site from 29 May. Traffic management will be in place to ensure safe passage for all vehicles on the road. Please obey all signage and traffic controls during this time
- Small rock and fill transport by two road trains daily from Howard Springs quarry along Gunn Point Road and Howard Springs Road to site
- Small rock fill transport by two road trains daily from Mt Bunday quarry along Arnhem and Stuart highways and Howard Springs Road to site
- Six concrete trucks daily travelling from Winnellie batching plant along Tiger Brennan Drive, Stuart Highway and Howard Springs Road to site
- Extended working hours will be necessary until July as we near commissioning of Phase One. Concrete pouring will commence on site at 6am from Monday to Saturday – this is to compensate for hot weather. Normal activities will continue from 7am to 7pm Monday to Saturday. Low impact activities, such as internal finishes to buildings (painting and tiling), will continue from 7pm to midnight Monday to Saturday
- Sunday site works will include construction of the Stow Road sewer pump station access road as well as both internal and external work on site. Work hours will be restricted to between 9am and 4pm

**JKC and a number of other contractors are now carrying out work on or near Howard Springs Road. Please help keep everyone safe on our roads by obeying all speed limits and signage.**

**Cyclists please take extra care when crossing Howard Springs Road.**

Appropriate dust suppression and street sweeping measures are in place at all JKC construction sites. All truck rock loads are covered. Noise, dust and road conditions will continue to be monitored.
